IV. Old Business: Discussion about the Central Coast CAPTO coin was again brought to the group, and a sample of it was passed around. The group agreed that a sun with rays or something else, needed to be placed in the area representing the sky. A decision was made to contact Symbolarts and get a sample of the coin with sun/rays in the sky. If there is a consensus of the coin looking good, and no objections are brought forth, Craig Hendricks motioned to order the coin through Symbolarts, and Lisa Chesson second the motion. The motion passed unopposed.

-Dedication of new EVOC track at Lompoc: Greg Dossey indicated that no final decision has yet to be made on this; however, the college President and Board of Trustees are supportive of the idea, and are still working through the details. Greg also mentioned that POST's Executive Director, Paul Capitelli, sent in a letter to the President of the college, and reinforced the point that Bill had contributed at least if not more than the \$500,000.00 needed (in time and equipment to the college) to legitimize the dedication.
