- II. Treasurer's Report: Larry Cooper provided the Treasurer's Report, attached. Assets are \$16,273.34 and are down slightly as a result of the \$400 dues split sent to CAPTO State and the \$100 gift certificate purchased as the CAPTO Award for the top cadet academically in Hancock College Police Academy Class 96 graduating May 28. Larry also gave a briefing on membership, reminding everyone that dues are collected annually after July 1 for the new fiscal year.
- III. POST Report: None, as the POST consultant was not in attendance. As requested, members present were briefed on the course decertification process effective June 30th of each year and requested to finish course modifications prior to May 30th to enable time for review and approval before June 30th. If a course is automatically decertified as a result of the annual process, the course will have to be submitted as a new course and approved before any presentations can be certified. - IV. New Business: Election of Officers for FY 2009-10. Discussion of duties of various positions and vacancies. Larry Cooper and Craig Hendricks expressed their desire to "pass the torch." Laura Perry (Ventura PD Training Coordinator) volunteered for Treasurer and was nominated. Troy Parker (Atascadero State Hospital DPS Training Officer) volunteered for Vice-President and was nominated. Bryan Cox (Pismo Beach PD Training Sergeant) volunteered for President and was nominated. Dan Falat (Operations Chief, State Parks) expressed interest in the Sergeant-at-Arms position, if it were to become open. Secretary Chrissy Alvarez (Santa Maria PD Training Coordinator) Secretary and Sergeant-at-Arms John Bewick (Grover Beach PD Lt.) will be contacted to see if they are interested in remaining in their positions. A quorum was not determined to be present, so balloting will be by email of paid members next week.

Election Results: Secretary Alvarez and Sgt-at-Arms Bewick agreed to their re-nominations and ballots were emailed to current members on May 26. On June 11, 2009, the president had received 13 aye votes for the nominated board members and one abstention. A majority is declared and the election is official.
