V. New Business: A motion was proposed by Bryan Cox to nominate former Central Coast Chapter President Craig Hendrick's and former Central Coast Chapter Treasurer Larry Cooper with a Life Membership for their previous assignments and outstanding services (which of course was questioned by Sergeant-At-Arms John Bewick =).
