- V. New Business: Greg Dossey sent a letter to the AHC President and Board of Trustees requesting the new EVOC Track in Lompoc to be dedicated and named for the late Bill Stearns. Greg also spoke with Tricia Chisum (prior to her departure), and she sent a letter to Paul Capitelli requesting a letter be sent to the AHC President and Board of Trustees as well, indicating how much Bill Stearns brought to the EVOC center at AHC.
