



Central Valley CAPTO Meeting
January 13, 2010
MEETING MINUTES
Host: Tulare County

1. Call to Order/Introductions
 - a. Meeting was called to order at 10:50 by Chapter President Tim Wilmore. 2. Treasurer's Report
 - a. Steve provided the end of year accounts as: Checking \$5,000.00; Savings CD \$13,189.86.
3. Approval of Minutes
 - a. There were no written minutes to approve from the previous meetings. Rosanna was unable to attend the September and November meetings due to illness.
4. Old Business

The Academy Instructor Certification Course is in progress. When the Training Center is up and running, they will offer a perishable skills package available to other agencies.

Rosanna is participating in POST workshops to develop 11 CPT courses that will be made available on the POST Learning Portal when complete. Work on the website continues with additions to the training calendar being the majority of the work.

 - g. Tulare County SO – Nothing to report.
