### **3. State Financial & Membership Report**

Jalaine distributed a financial report which included the following information:

- Public Safety Dispatch Advisory Council to POST Rosanna McKinney

Various dispatch organizations were represented with the intent of bringing them together to establish a Public Safety Dispatch Advisory Council to POST.
