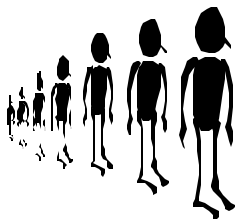

Again this year we will feature Jim Vidakovich, author, Emmy Award winner and multimedia management and training consultant. He will be the Plenary Speaker on Monday afternoon and follow-up with workshops on Tuesday.
