#### **Post Report:**

Steve Chaney commented on the following items:

- **Dispatcher Compliance:** Be aware when hiring lateral dispatchers. If they haven't already completed the Basic Course, they will be required to complete it.
- **Detective Symposium:** A Detective Symposium sponsored by the Robert Presley Institute on DNA and Interviewing Techniques will be held May 10-12 at San Jose State University.
- **First Responder Terrorism Courses** Be aware that these courses must be SB1350 compliant in order to meet the legislative mandate for this training. Not all courses being offered are SB1350 compliant.
- **Taser Training:** Believes that in the future it is very possible that POST will be asked to set a "minimum standardized curriculum" for taser training.
- **POST Coordinators Course:** Next 16 hr. course is scheduled for March 22-24 in Redondo Beach.

## POST COMMISSION ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT

---

The last POST Commission Meeting was held on January 20, 2005 and the Advisory Committee to the Commission meeting was held on January 19, 2005 both in Long Beach.

POST staff presented on the following topics:

1. Expanded Course Outline Exemption- eliminates the requirement for presenters to submit an updated course outline for certain courses: Regular Basic Academy, all Reserve Modules, Specialized Investigators' Basic Course, POST Requalification Course, and the Public Safety Dispatcher's Basic Course.
2. POST staff is reviewing the Reading and Writing Requirement for Entry-Level Police Officer as it relates to performing job tasks and the feasibility of raising the requirements.
3. POST staff is continuing the on-going process of updating the Basic Course Learning Domains and Testing Specifications.
4. Approval of a contract to computerize the course certification process via the Internet.
5. Contract request to develop a web-based version of the Law Enforcement Response to Terrorism course (SB 1350).
6. Pilot presentation and evaluation of the SWAT Commanders course in March.

7. The proposed POST budget is approx. \$60 million which is pretty much the status quo.

The Committee reviewed and made recommendations of the Governor's Award Recipients.

The next POST Commission Meeting and Advisory Committee will be held on April 20 & 21, 2005 in Burlingame, CA.
